

Fortunately, Fannie's black cook, Queenie, and her smart-mouthed daughter, Dollbaby, take it upon themselves to initiate Ibbby into the ways of the South, both its grand traditions and its darkest secrets.

For Fannie's own family history is fraught with tragedy, hidden behind the closed rooms in her ornate Uptown mansion. It will take Ibbby's arrival to begin to unlock the mysteries there. And it will take Queenie and Dollbaby's hard-won wisdom to show Ibbby that family can sometimes be found in the least expected places.

For fans of *Saving CeeCee Honeycutt* and *The Help*, *Dollbaby* brings to life the charm and unrest of 1960s New Orleans through the eyes of a young girl learning to understand race for the first time.
